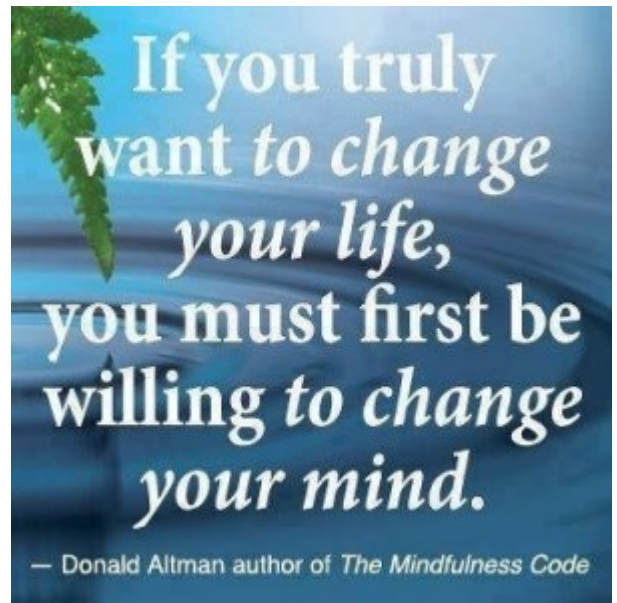


# Hindrances to Research

- *Not knowing how to **narrow** your research.*
- *Willingness to **adapt** your research when it is needed.*
- *Willingness to be **wrong**.*
- *A sense of knowing that what you write about now can be **accurate** but **later** it may not be as relevant or even **wrong**.*



I have found in many of my research papers I have ended them with questions that I still had. I would go back to a paper that I wrote years ago and found that my view-point has completely changed. I now know that if I want to **excel** in writing I need to focus of these hindrances.
